Permit to Burn

Subject to the following conditions and the provision of The Wildfires Act and Municipal By-Law# 2022-07

1. To keep fire under control at all times.
2. To bear responsibility for all property damage which may result from burning done under this permit.
3. To fireguard the area as required under the terms of The Wildfires Act.
4. Permittee must call the Crop Residue information line daily before burning
5. The municipality may ban ALL BURNING in the RM of Riding Mountain West if fires are of risk, and such a ban would prevent wildfires from occurring then all Burning Permits would be revoked.
6. Burn Permits are free of charge and are valid for a 2 week duration.

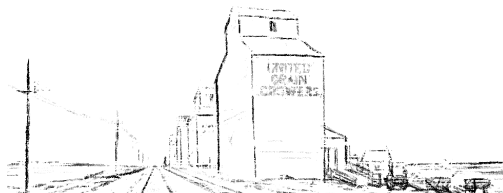
